Picnic in the Park

Did you know that Slough has 76 parks and outdoor spaces for you to explore? 22 of them have outdoor gyms for you to use.

There are playgrounds for younger children, tennis courts, skate parks and multi-use games areas (MUGA) available at certain parks.

Pack up your lunch and enjoy a local park for the day or try one of the cycle routes. Take a look at www.slough.gov.uk/parks-green-spaces for your nearest park, play area, your local recreation ground or green space that will provide you with free recreation and plenty of enjoyment for everyone.




Here are just a few of the parks and open spaces.

- **Herschel Park** has seating and free parking. Where you can spend time at the lake and wildlife ponds or enjoy the nature reserve. You can also have a picnic in the reserved area.
- **Upton Court Park** has waterside paths, football pitches and play areas. From here you can also walk to Windsor.
- **Salt Hill Park** has gardens with tennis courts, a skate park and a café.
- **Ditton Park** contains the Historical Ditton Manor House with a moat and landscaped gardens.
- **Pippins Park** is where you can find a green area with seating, a herb garden and a Children's playground.
- **Fruit picking** - Kids love picking their own raspberries and strawberries in the summer. It's a great way to get them eating healthy treats too. Copas Farms have a pick your own farm in Cookham and Iver - visit www.thefruitfields.co.uk/
- **Splash around** - Runnymede Pleasure Grounds (www.visitsurrey.com/things-to-do/runnymede-pleasuregrounds-p1067391) opens its paddling pool during the summer months. With an enclosed play area, children's amusements and a café, there's plenty to keep the kids occupied.
- **Get baking** - Everyone wants a sweet treat over the holidays, and what's better than baking it yourself? Why not try your hand at baking a cake or biscuits.
- **Get creative in the garden** - Set a tent up in your back garden and have a BBQ; try a treasure hunt with small treats, setup a mini crazy golf circuit, camp out and star gaze.

- **Dorney Lake** Keep fit by cycling or walking around the lake.
- **Black Park** Walk around the lake. Play in the adventure playground or enjoy a fun run. Try Go Ape tree top adventures or Nets Kingdom/Trampoline.
- **Burnham Beeches** Have a game of cricket, rounders or football. Why not picnic in the park. See the cows grazing.
- **Langley Park** Cycle or walk through the woods on the scenic trail. See the rhododendrons and arboretum. Build a den. Look out for the lake and wildlife.
- **Runnymede Pleasure Grounds** Have a picnic or a splash in the paddling pool.
- **Ruislip Lido** Enjoy a trip to a man-made beach, ride on a train or walk in the woods. Enjoy an ice cream in the café.
- **Liquid Leisure** is a water activity park in Datchet.
- **Denham Country Park** is a nature reserve where you can enjoy the countryside.
- **Odds Farm Park** Visit animals such as pigs, sheep and chickens.
- **Chiltern open air museum** Discover 30 historic buildings, woodland trails, working farm and more.
- **Beale Park** is a outdoor wildlife park with an exciting mix of animals and attractions.
- **Legoland** is a child orientated theme park. 
- **Windsor** - visit the castle or swim at the leisure centre, take a boat trip or walk along the river. See how many swans or ducks you can count.
- **Travel to London** and visit free activities such as the Natural History Museum.
