What's included in the subscription?

- Access to an Online Safety Officer for assistance in developing and implementing strategies related to online safety. Advise on digital safeguarding and provide appropriate online safety education in curriculum development; promote responsible use of technology; empower children to remain safe online
- Safeguarding Newsletter Three times a year
- Information/advice as and when needed via phone/email including case escalation
- Supporting and managing Ofsted/DfE complaints including school follow up & reporting
- Two free CPD sessions a year for DSL's/DDSL's safeguarding
- Annual 'New to the role welcome meeting/Induction' for DSL in those roles (twice a year)
- Discounted rates for attending additional CPD sessions/events throughout the year (30%)
- Discounted rates for whole school safeguarding training (20%)
