

KNIFE ANGEL— SAFE RELATIONSHIPS WORKSHOPS

As part of the legacy of the Knife Angel's visit to Slough, Safer Slough Partnership has commissioned 8 domestic abuse and safe relationship workshops to be run in secondary schools. The sculpture, which visited Slough throughout January 2023, was specifically created to highlight the negative effects of all violent behaviour whilst solidifying our critical need for social change. These 1 hour workshops are available on a first come, first served basis, to support young people to identify the features of healthy and unhealthy relationships.



What is on Offer

- Workshops suitable for Years 7-13
- The workshops are age appropriate, and cover forms of relationship abuse and warning signs of an abusive relationship
- Can be tailored to the needs of the school, to include topics such as sexual consent, harassment and revenge porn.
- The workshops cover how to access help/who to speak to, and are relevant for both students' relationships, and for identifying abuse in others' relationships.
