INTRODUCTION

The BBC Gladiators micro:bit competition is a partnership between Gladiators, BBC Education and the Micro:bit Educational Foundation, designed specifically for students aged 7 – 11 years old.

Teachers will be fully supported with <u>curriculum-aligned lesson plans</u> to guide their students. Schools can submit a maximum of three entries. Simply block out an afternoon and let your class dive into a fun, creative learning experience they won't want to miss. With exciting prizes, it's a fantastic opportunity to inspire your students.

Entry window closes at midday on 6th December 2024.



PRIZE BREAKDOWN

- The winning school will receive an in-person visit from a Gladiator and be awarded a £500 voucher for computing equipment. They will have their design turned into a prototype gadget and enjoy a special Gladiator-themed micro:bit coding day with a BBC micro:bit expert.
- **2. The 3 runners up** will each receive a £500 voucher for computing equipment, a classroom set of micro:bits and a Gladiator-themed micro:bit coding day with a BBC micro:bit expert.
- **3. The top 50 entries** will be selected in Round 1 by professional judges from the Institution of Mechanical Engineers (IMechE). These entries will each receive a classroom set of micro:bits. In Round 2, a panel of experts including IMechE, the Micro:bit Educational Foundation and Nominet will review the shortlist to pick the winner and 3 runners up.
