

Slough Group Supervision for DSLs

November 2021 to August 2022

What is it?

'Supervision' is very different from 'line management' and focuses on building a safe space to support the development of knowledge, skills, confidence, and reflective practice in the workplace. To help DSLs make informed judgements and sound decision making. The group discussions will provide emotional support for often isolated and demanding specialist roles/functions to discuss worries, and feelings.

Who will run the sessions?

Qualified counsellors with experience of providing reflective supervision to practitioners, two of whom have teaching/education backgrounds.

What will it cost?

£50 per session for 1st place and 20% discount for subsequent places for DDSLs (£40).



How often will it run?

Six sessions per academic year
(Six weekly - half termly)

What time of the day?

Twilight from 4-5.30pm

When will the sessions start?

Week commencing 1 November 2021
